The dates for the upcoming supplementary election have now been confirmed and are:

- Close of rolls 5:00 pm, Tuesday 20 December 2022
- Nominations open Friday 13 January 2023
- Nominations close 12 noon Friday 27 January 2023 (Thursday 26 January is Australia Day)
- Mail out period Wednesday 15 February 2023 to Tuesday 21 February 2023
- •Close of voting (polling day) 12 noon Tuesday 14 March 2023 (Monday 13 March is Adelaide Cup)

We in conjunction with the Electoral Commission of South Australia will be promoting awareness of the supplementary election and it's phases (enrolment, nominations, and vote), via

press, email, SMS, social media, and other media. However, initially I remind everyone to check and update your postal address and encourage those with businesses, rental property owners and holiday homeowners to enrol before the 20th of December 2022.

I would also highlight that nominations open on Friday 13th January 2023 and encourage you to nominate for your local Council and help shape the future of your community.

SUMMARY - MEDICAL SERVICES

We have a <u>contract</u> with SA Health to provide General Practitioner Services to the Streaky Bay Hospital, *What does this mean?* The Streaky Bay and District Medical Clinic has an obligation to provide GP Services to the hospital 365 days per year, 24 hours per day. How do we do this? At present we have one resident GP who provides 50% of the service, and the Clinic engages Locums to undertake the other 50%

We have one resident GP who is contracted on a full time basis to undertake medical services at the clinic

We have one part time/casual GP who is contracted to the clinic to assist with backfill, immunisations and other minor medical services when required

The Rural Doctors Workforce Agency (RDWA) provide an Outreach Women's Health Service from the Clinic, RDWA contract the clinic to utilize a room only for this service, all income is received by the RDWA

OUR HISTORY

The Streaky Bay Medical Clinic was privately owned, before it was purchased by the District Council of Streaky Bay at the desire of the community to then be transitioned the clinic into a not-for-profit community owned clinic.

OUR BOARD

The Clinic operates as an incorporated association under the Associations Incorporations Act 1985, with a **volunteer** Board that oversees its operations on behalf of the members of the association.

There are 8 Board Members, including one Council representative. The Board meets on a Bi-Monthly basis and its operations are audited annually and operate in accordance with the Associations Incorporations Act 1985.

OUR RESPONSIBILITIES

The board is responsible for the engagement of staff at the clinic, GP contracts, external agency contracts and contract arrangements with other bodies. The board must ensure the clinic remains financially viable.

THE HOSPITAL

The Streaky Bay Hospital is an SA Health Facility that operates under the Eyre Far North Local Health Network (EFNLHN), the Clinic provides GP's to service the hospital, EFNLHN do not provide GP services to the Hospital.

OUR STAFF

The clinic has limited staff with 1 Full Time Practice Manager, 1 Part Time Receptionist and 1 Part Time Practice Nurse.

OUR GENERAL PRACTICTIONERS

The Clinic has 1 resident GP serving a permanent population of 2200 with a holiday season population of over 3000, along with year round provision of GP services to the hospital this has resulted in the engagement of Locums to support this level of service provision.

WHY DO WE GET CHARGED? WHY DON'T WE BULK BILL?

As a not for profit association the Clinic operates the same as a private business where by the Clinic pays all employee wages, insurances equipment, supplies, rent, utilities and other expenses relating to the operation of the clinic. As the clinic has a higher turnover than most associations it is registered for GST.

The clinic receives 30% of all consults income from the permanent GP and 100% of Locums, however we struggle to cover costs due to the engagement of locums at around \$2500 per day plus travel expenses and agency fees, this results in the Clinic running at a loss, as the income earned does not cover the costs. We have no option other than to engage Locums to cover the 50% on-call roster at the Hospital.

The rebate provided by medicare has not increased enough over the years to cover general medical practice expenses. Therefore the payment of a gap fee by patients is required to ensure that both our hospital and our clinic remains operational and our community can receive GP, EMERGENCY and IN PATIENT CARE.



AgriFutures Horizon Scholarship applications open today

Applications for the 2023 AgriFutures Horizon Scholarship Program are now open. Students entering their final two years of an undergraduate degree who are passionate about the future of Australian rural industries are encouraged to apply.

The AgriFutures Horizon Scholarship is a collaboration between many of the Research and Development Corporations (RDC's), along with Cooperative Research Centre for Developing Northern Australia, FMC Australasia, AgriProve and Kalyx to provide eligible university students with a \$10,000 bursary over two years and plenty of opportunities to develop their leadership skills and expand their networks. As part of the Program, students also attend an annual four-day professional development workshop and complete two weeks of industry work placements per year.

The Horizon Scholarship Program is open to students studying agriculture-related or STEM degrees with major studies and/or subject selections that align to agriculture.

AgriFutures Australia Managing Director, John Harvey says that attracting people from non-traditional agricultural backgrounds will be crucial to solving the workforce challenges of the future and is excited to see the Horizon Scholarship Program evolve to meet this need.

"Our cohorts are no longer made up solely of ag students from traditional farming backgrounds. We now have scholars studying engineering, law, business and communications," said Mr Harvey.

"We have scholars from the inner city in the same room as students from cattle stations in central Queensland, and this diversity in backgrounds and thinking is beginning to elevate the conversations beyond anything we've seen before."

This was the experience for current Horizon Scholar, Thomas McPherson.

"There are some brilliant ideas flowing when we get together because we all have a common goal of wanting to improve and make a difference in agriculture.

"Agriculture has some issues that probably have simple solutions but others that require pretty complex solutions. Being in a position where I have the privilege to soak up as much information as possible from those around me, even people you meet along



the way at a conference, has been incredible and what I've enjoyed the most," Tom said.

The diverse range of industry sponsors involved in the Horizons Scholarship program represents the desire to build prosperous and sustainable rural industries. To do this, there is a need to build the skills, capacity, leadership and knowledge of the future rural leaders of Australian agriculture.

"Creating a platform for students to collaborate across traditional and emerging areas of agriculture will create a platform of networking, idea creation and forward thinking that is invaluable to the rural industries of the future and I thank all of the industry sponsors who recognise the value and importance of the investment into future leaders.

Council Waste Matters

Cardboard is free to drop off at the Transfer Station and greatly reduces the volume in your kerbside bin reducing what goes to landfill.

The cardboard is baled on site and freighted to YCA Recycling in Adelaide for recycling. A truck load of 80 bales was transported in January.

A reminder that the transfer station accepts the following non-deposit items for recycling:-

- Plastic milk and cream bottles, washed with the lids removed opaque in colour
- Cardboard, cut or broken up into pieces that fit into a 240litre wheelie bin (please note that cardboard and cardboard boxes not to the correct size will be charged)
- Tin and steel cans, e.g. fruit tins, soup cans, etc. washed with the lid put inside the tin

Please ensure your waste is sorted prior to arrival, this avoids contamination of waste.

The Environment Protection Authority (EPA) has imposed strict conditions on the disposal of waste in South Australia. The attendant will direct you to where your waste is to be placed – penalties will be imposed on Council for contaminated waste by the EPA. Your cooperation in sorting your waste is greatly appreciated.

The attendant has the right to refuse any waste that is not sorted.
