Council News

GOVERNANCE

Human Resource Movements

Community and Economic Development Administration – welcome to the team Melissa Benc who was successful and will replace Tracey Tape whilst Tracey is backfilling the Executive Assistant to the CEO position.

Congratulations to Amber Bawden who has chosen to take up employment with state government. Amber has been a valued member of the team working across a number of roles in her time with Council.

Council also farewells Prue Dawes, Prue has been on maternity leave for a year and has chosen to pursue other opportunities. Prue had a key role in the Infrastructure Team with project management and we thank her for her time and dedication to Council.

COMMUNITY

Health and Community Hub Feasibility Study

Council received a report seeking Council's interest in staff pursuing funding for a feasibility study into a developing a purpose-built health and community hub in an effort to attract potential professionals in the future.

Over the past months, several discussions have been held with medical providers regarding the attraction of medical professionals to the region with one of the detractors cited as being the lack of modern infrastructure from which to work from. Council resolved to enable staff to pursue funding options.

Request for Land to develop housing for GP's in the Evre Peninsula

The Northern Eyre Peninsula Health Alliance (NEPHA) and Regional Development Australia have approached Council with the request to commit to funding proposal to be submitted to Federal Government regarding the donation of land from Council for federal government funding to be then utilized to build housing GP's and other medical staff.

The proposal is for 11 houses to be established across the EP with 3 at Streaky Bay. Council resolved that should the Federal Funding be successful they would donate 3 allotments for the purposes of building the houses.

Streaky Bay Area School Pool

The Streaky Bay Area School Pool is due for opening following extensive maintenance undertaken by the Department for Education, hopefully we will see some warmer weather.

Council have engaged pool attendants, however if you are interested in a casual position please call.

Third Party or Private Hire of the Pool needs to be undertaken through the Streaky Bay Area School.

Child Care Facility Development

Council received a deputation in October 2021 regarding the future establishment of a childcare facility for Streaky Bay. Several locations have been investigated and deemed unsuitable for various reasons.

Council received a report to the December 2021 ordinary meeting of Council to pursue the purchase of Crown Land on Montgomerie Terrace for the purpose of the Child Care Facility and potential other facilities in the future.

Council resolved to pursue this option with a Memorandum of Understanding being established between Council and the private developer regarding the costs associated with the purchase of the land. Please refer to that report for full details.

Golf Course Crown Land Purchase

Following the determination of Native Title over the Crown Land that is the Golf Course in Streaky Bay, this determination meant that many allotments have Native Title over just a portion of a single allotment. Council received a report with a proposal to now subdivide these allotments with a view to Council purchasing those allotments that would bring those portions of the golf course under Council ownership (no longer Crown Land). Council resolved to further pursue this opportunity.

Australia Day Awards and Ceremony

Council have collated and considered all the nominations received and all nominees for the respective awards have been notified. Award Winners will be presented via on online virtual event on the day.

Art Attack Event – Streaky Bay Community Hall

Unfortunately for the second time and due to the change in restrictions with Covid19 this event is again postponed until later in the year.

TOURISM AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Perlubie Beach (Crown Land) - Management

Council had been working closely with Crown Land regarding the ongoing management of Perlubie Beach with a view to pursuing care and control of the area from the crown.

In these negotiations and with recent Native Title determinations, the portion of land is under Native Title.

Council had two options in continuing these negotiations which were to either pursue and negotiate an Indigenous Land Use Agreement directly with the Native Title Holders or await the outcomes of the State negotiation for their Indigenous Land Use Agreement (ILUA). Council resolved to await the state negotiations.

Community Strengthening and Planning Committee – Independent Vacancy

Council welcomes Lauren Karp into the position of independent member for this Vacancy.

Tractor Beach and Speeds Point (Crown Land) – Management

These sites are similar in nature regarding Native Title holders and Council also resolved to await the state ILUA outcomes in relation to these ongoing negotiations.

New Year's Eve 2021

It was great to see the Fireworks go ahead to bring in 2022. Congratulations to the Streaky Bay Community Hotel Board and Graham Davis for dedicating their time to make this event happen.

It was unfortunate that due to a change in the restrictions in simply became too prohibitive to hold the Children's Festival, with several similar events across the state also being cancelled.

CEO UPDATE

As we are all aware, COVID 19 is now moving through our community. Which has presented several challenges to Council operations with a number of staff having to isolate and be tested after being identified as being in close contact with a COVID positive case. Considering this, we have made several changes to our operations to ensure business continuity throughout the next few months.

In terms of events, we have had to cancel the Children's New Year's festival, postpone the Community BBQ and Council meeting at Wirrulla, postpone the art attack event and stream Council meetings online. We have also made the decision to cancel the Australia Day BBQ but will still be running the awards ceremony on a yet to be announced online forum. We understand that we are entering a new phase of the pandemic and we have to learn to live with COVID19 in our community. However, considering the current speed of the spread of COVID19 throughout our communities. We also need to support a model of reducing large-scale interactions to help slow the spread within our community.

As the COVID situation changes and evolves, we may see further change depending on what happens within the local community and at a state level.

Additionally, when we start to move out of the pandemic, we will revert our operations back to normal and look at the opportunity to redeploy some of the resources allocated to cancelled events to facilitate an event for the community to assist with rebuilding community connectiveness, post pandemic.

We thank everyone for their continued understanding and patience as we 'learn to live' with COVID and deal with this ever changing and fluid situation.






