THIS IS ALL ABOUT POO SO LISTEN UP

We need to talk about dog poo and picking it up because there seems to be copious amounts throughout our town. Some of us just know it's common sense, good neighbourly and the right thing to do to pick up after their dog or maybe just plain embarrassing if someone sees them leave it there.

It's called being "poo shamed" and you just don't want to be that person. Some of us couldn't give a poo, so they do leave it for someone else to clean up or step in and that is called "gross", and you should be ashamed of yourself. So, for the benefit of those who just don't care let me share some information on why you should. Firstly, it's the law.

Under the Dog and Cat Management Act, a person who is responsible for the control of a dog is guilty of an offence if the dog dumps in a public place and that person doesn't immediately clean it up. Maximum penalty \$1,250; expiation fee \$210. And did you know that under our Dogs By-Law, no person is to allow a dog under their control to be in a public place or on Local Government land unless that person has in their possession a bag or other suitable container for the collection and lawful disposal of the gear the dog has dumped. No bag means they can't comply with the Act which means the same fine. So, if you're out walking Fido and I ask you to show me your dog bags and you have none then we have a problem, and the answer is you'll probably be fined \$210.

Here's some additional points to think about as a dog owner:

- Dog poo can contain bacteria, parasites and pathogens that can directly and indirectly cause people to get sick.
- Although you may think that the poo disappears over time or is washed away, micro-organisms such as roundworms, E. coli and giardia parasites can persist and survive in that area for up to 4 years.
- A common culprit associated with water contamination is fecal coliform bacteria, a type of bacteria found in animal waste. There is a demonstrated relationship between the presence of illness causing viruses that are harmful to humans if accidentally swallowed with water or eaten with contaminated shellfish.
- Consider what diseases your dog or other's dogs can contract from infected poo. Think canine parvovirus, canine hepatitis, distemper, canine gastroenteritis. Most are highly contagious and often fatal (especially for puppies!).

So, here's what YOU can do for the rest of us:

1. Vaccinate your dog.
2. Worm your dog.
3. Clean up after your dog.

The Streaky Bay Council provides dog bags at various locations around the town and at Back Beach, but it is your responsibility to be prepared for an event or be prepared to be fined.

No crap. Nice work.

Community School Pool

Rules

The following rules must be observed by pool patrons at all times when using the pool and its facilities.

- Persons are not permitted to enter the pool without payment of fees. Pool supervisor reserves the right to check for Annual Pool passes.

- Persons must not enter the pool grounds without appropriate personnel on site
- Appropriate swimwear must be worn at all times (see details below)
- Do not use pool if you are feeling unwell or showing symptoms of cold or flu, or directed to be isolating in accordance with SA Health Regulations
- Do not use pools if you have suffered from diarrhoea in the past week.
- Do not use pool if you have any open wounds
- Members and guests, not toilet trained must wear swim nappies.
- In the instant that faeces enters the pool the Pool Supervisor **MUST** be notified immediately and the pool must be closed immediately
- The pool is a multi-use pool.
- Nappies are not to be changed at poolside. Please make use of the toilets or lawn areas.
- Safety Equipment must not be tampered with
- Pool Users are not permitted to enter the Plant Room
- Pool Users are not permitted to use school equipment relating to the pool
- Do NOT RUN
- Do NOT PUSH or THROW People In
- Diving and Jumping are only permitted in the deep end of the pool
- NO glass, food or drinks (other than water) are allowed in the pool area.
- NO Smoking or alcohol is allowed within the school grounds
- Soft Water toys may be used at the discretion of the lifeguard.
- Body boards and surfboards are not permitted.
- Sitting or hanging on lap lanes is prohibited.
- Avoid eating or consuming alcoholic beverages before using the pool.
- Animals are prohibited.
- If animals are found within the pool (i.e. Snakes), notify the supervisor immediately
- Behaviour deemed not conducive to public safety will not be permitted.
- Boisterous or dangerous behaviour will not be tolerated.
- The pool must be vacated during electrical storms.
- The lifeguards have full authority to enforce rules in pool facilities
- All rubbish and waste must be removed from the Pool area and users are responsible for the disposal of their own waste

Child Supervision

- Children 8 years and under are not permitted to use the pool without adult supervision and that supervision must be undertaken from an adult seated within the designated pool area
- Children 5 years and under must be accompanied by an adult in the water
- An adult must be at least 18 years old

On Saturday 6th January 100 anglers, aged between 3 and 17 years, cast off for the 21st anniversary of Family Fish Day at 9.00am.

Organisers, the Streaky Bay Tourism & Business Association Inc, were delighted to host the event, given the torrential rains experienced the day before.

A warm sunny sky welcomed the participants which was made up of a range of locals and visitors from Northern Territory, Queensland, New South Wales and a number of families from Adelaide.

The Fisheries team came to support the event by handing out a pamphlet on the various species, answered questions and advocated responsible fishing.

On the spot prizes were awarded to anglers courteously of Killas the major sponsor which included 6 rod and reel combinations plus 6 tackles boxes and a range of fishing paraphernalia given away as mystery prizes delighting the recipients.

No angler went home empty handed with all receiving a Shimano cap and stickers.

The prize money was increased to celebrate the 21st year. Biggest Catch of the Day was awarded to angler 52 winning \$300 plus a quality rod, reel plus trophy for a 1.22kg Flathead. The runner up angler 23 also catching a Flathead weighing 0.71kg received \$200 plus a rod, reel and trophy.

A catch and release policy applied to all anglers on the day which must have disappointed those catching good sized Flathead.

Again this year event committee members Gary Finch and Graham Redding generously donated the rods and reels which were appreciated by the anglers awarded for largest aggregate weight caught on the day angler 52 and greatest number of fish caught by angler 53 during the two hour competition. Even the Unluckiest angler, a lad from Adelaide, took home a quality rod and reel plus trophy which has been kindly donated year-after-year by community sponsors Janet and Donald Williams.

A range of trophies were allocated randomly to participants such as:

Fish quiver at the mention of my name,

Keep calm and keep fishing,

Jetty Champion and;

21st Anniversary Trophy.

The Streaky Bay Community Hotel generously arranged a raffle of a beach cabana, beach towel and 1.5 litre bottle of Peter Lehmann Rose. The lucky winner was S. Tomney.

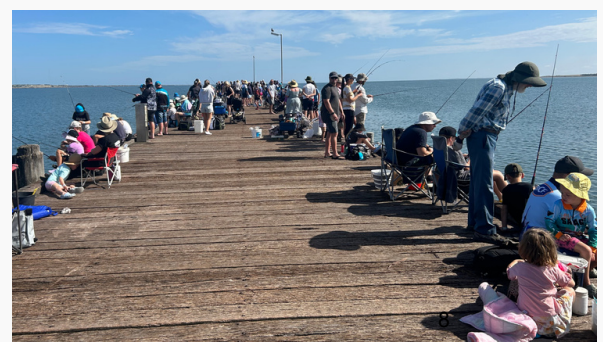

The District Council of Streaky Bay provided additional seating and games which really added to the festivities.

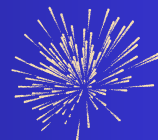

The events were supported with a lot of participants competing in each one, like the under 11 perlubie endurance over 800mtrs with 44 kids taking part whereas the under 14 endurance over 800 mtrs only had 12 entrants.

The mens open endurance was won by Max Norrish and second was Will McAvaney as where in the womens event return competitor Zahlil Reid took out first place with young Eva Schmucker close behind in second place.

Ideal Beach girl 6 yrs and under was taken out by Gloriana Hein and the Mr muscles for 6 years and under was won by young Ivan Dickson.

This was the start of a good day for the Dickson family as his dad Chris And Mum Mariah were back competing the volleyball as defending champions from last year with their fellow team mates Rowan Chester and Tyson Lydeamore. And took out the title again this year.

The other event of the day that drew attention right near the end was the open men's high jump. The record for this event was set in 1992 by local Mib Baldock at 1.88mtrs, and was being pushed by another local young lad Callan Buckley who came within a whisker of it winning the event clearing a height of 1.86mtrs.

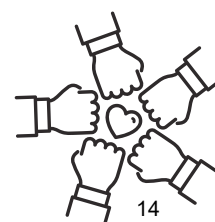

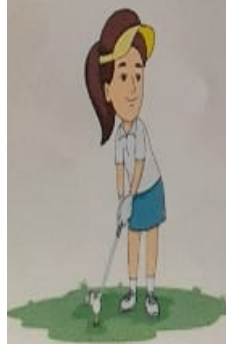
