ABOUT OUR DISTRICT

The town of Streaky Bay is the main urban service centre of the district, with the smaller towns Wirrulla and Poochera as local service centres. Haslam, Sceale Bay, Baird Bay, Yanerbie, Eba Anchorage, Perlubie Landing and Fishermans Paradise are small coastal settlements, which provide a focus for recreational fishing and holiday accommodation.

It is intended that Streaky Bay will remain the centre for commerce and industry whilst providing the main health, educational, community and shopping services of the district. The District's core economic pillars are agriculture, aquaculture and tourism, with industries such as energy resource development and mining, increasingly providing potential diversification of our industrial base.

The District Council of Streaky Bay is located approximately 700 kilometres north-west of Adelaide. Sitting on the western side of the bountiful Eyre Peninsula, our generally flat and fertile inland agricultural landscapes of Calca and Mount Cooper, lead to spectacular long sandy beaches, large dune formations and the rugged cliff lines of our pristine coast.







Hard Waste Disposal

Council offers free disposal of hard waste at the transfer station 4 times a year, visit the Council website www.streakybay.sa.gov.au/council-services/waste-management/hardwastecollection to find out when the next free hard waste week is planned and for allowable items, limits and opening times during this week.

General Waste Information

Kerbside collection services are undertaken utilising a 140 litre mobile garbage bin only.

Residents are responsible for supplying their own 140 litre bin. All 140 litre bins must display a Council logo sticker on the front of the bin for identification and collection by the contractor, to be collected at the Council Office.

DOGS & CATS

All dogs and cats three months or older must be registered with the District Council of Streaky Bay within 14 days of ownership and registered each year after 1 July and prior to 31 August. It is important to register your dog and cat so if it becomes lost, we can contact you to reunite you with your pet.

It is a requirement under the Dog and Cat Management Act 1995 that all dogs and cats are microchipped. All dogs and cats born from 1 July 2018 are also required to be desexed unless the owner is registered as a breeder.
